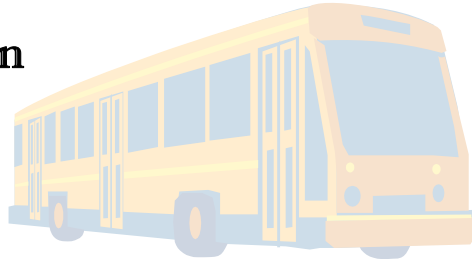


JISD Transportation 2008-2009 Bus Rules



▶ Crossing Street or Highway

1. Look in all directions before crossing streets
2. Never cross behind the bus
3. Watch for vehicles that do not stop when the bus is loading or unloading

▶ Getting Off the Bus

1. Stay seated until bus is stopped
2. Students are to only get off at their established stop
3. Always cross in front of the bus
4. Do no chase or hang on to the bus
5. If you drop an object and it rolls under the bus, get the driver's attention
6. A parent or guardian must be visible before a special needs student will be dropped off.*
Repeated incidents of no one to accept the student will result in loss of transportation.

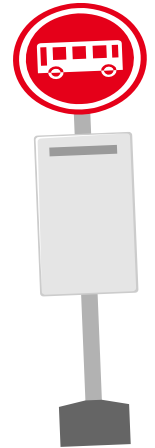
*The student will be returned to the Transportation Department—if student is/are not picked up by 5:30pm the Police Department and Child Protection Services will be contacted.

▶ Conduct On Bus

1. Remain seated
2. The driver is in charge of the bus
3. Arrive at your stop 10 minutes early
4. Always sit in your assigned seat
5. Shoving/fighting is prohibited on bus and at stop
6. No sexual harassment of any kind
7. Students must give correct name or be suspended

▶ Prohibited Items

1. Tobacco
2. Live animals or insects
3. Alcoholic beverages
4. Weapons, explosives, drugs
5. Matches or cigarette lighters
6. Food or drinks
7. Cell phones, CD players, or MP3 players



▶ Accidents or Emergencies

1. Follow the driver's instructions
2. If you must leave the bus stay in a group
3. Follow evacuation procedures
